Our Vision


MPS envisions an environment that facilitates growth and development for children, parents and all other members of the school's community.


WHY FIT IN, WHEN YOU WERE BORN TO STAND OUT- Dr Seuss



THE ELEMENTARY YEARS



THE EXERCISES OF PRACTICAL LIFE

Activites that directly help children become independent in their immediate environment. Through the activities done, there is great development and refinement of fine and gross motor skills. Children achieve eye-hand co-ordination, independence, self-confidence, self-reliance, a sense of order and care concentration, one on one communication and above all, are prepared for language and arithmetic.



THE ARITHMETIC MATERIAL


The emphasis here is on the value of the digit and the place it occupies in a number. A child learns by handing quantities and by counting in ones, tens, the power of tens and multiples of tens. The child grasps the concepts of the quantity of each number before rote counting.

One-one correspondence, the value of zero, greater and smaller quantities are some of the important concepts in number work done by the child in very simple, organized activities



THE SENSORIAL ACTIVITIES

Meant for training the five senses — visual, olfactory, auditory, gustatory and tactile. During the early more sensitive periods of a child's life, he/she uses his/her 5 senses to categorize the huge source of unclassified data gathered from their environment. Most sensorial materials are ten in quantity, which is an indirect exposure to counting and quantities. All activities are self-corrective. Sensorial materials also help adults identify whether a hearing problem or colour blindness exists in any child in his/her care.



THE PHONETIC METHOD

This is the mainstay method of reading, which relies on the sounds of the letters. The child is introduced to common sounds of the letters enabling him or her to learn and be ready to comprehend the consecutive sounds in a word. Reading therefore, takes place by lettersound relationships.



During elementary years we need to go beyond, using textbooks as a complete curriculum, or assessing children on the basis of pre-defined questions. At this stage children learn through various engaging activities which involve lot of Creativity and Curiosity.

Take a look at the terms related to the curriculum framework.



LANGUAGE ARTS

Language Arts are taught through a balanced literacy approach that integrates reading, writing, listening, speaking, word inquiry and handwriting. The youngest students are with books and express themselves in pictures and words in a meaningful way. Teachers build on each child's prior knowledge to develop literacy skills through a gradual and aligned process.



THE PHONIC WORD METHOD

This method is used for teaching words with blends and diagraphs namely "phonograms". (a blend is a word where two letter sounds come together and are read with their individual sounds remaining intact eg. words with pi, nd, bi etc. Diagraphs are words where two letter sounds come together to make new sounds eg. words with sh, ch, th, ee, oo etc.) In the phonic word method, letter sound relationships are learnt in the context of words to which they apply, through phonic drill and practice. By the time our child turns 4, he/she becomes a confident reader of English sentences and Hindi words without matras.



EDUCATIONAL VISITS

Educational Trips give students the chance to build closer bonds with their classmates. The type of memories that Educational trip creates called "episodic memories" help children retain information for longer period of time.



INQUIRY BASED LEARNING

"The meaning of 'knowing' has shifted from being able to remember and repeat information to being able to find and use it." (National Research Council, 2007)

Inquiry based learning is an umbrella term that incorporates many current learning approaches (including project based learning, design thinking and often hands-on-learning too) and may take various forms, depending on the topic, resources, ages and abilities of students and other variables.

Inquiry based learning encourages students to learn from each other, together with others and from those outside of the classroom context. Therefore, learning takes place in a social context.

Moreover, embarking on authentic inquiry based learning requires a mindset and skill set on the part of teachers as well. As a result, teachers work in collaboration with all stakeholders thus enhancing their own professional development and making learning process smooth for their students.

NEP 2020 is a milestone in the history of the education system in India. It will provide the much-needed tectonic shift in the pedagogical structure emphasizing experiential and practical learning that will instill 21st-century skills in children.

In alignment with the NEP, Meerut Public School Pallavpuram, has taken quite a few measures to make learning at schools holistic, skill driven, competency-oriented and joyful. Joyful Learning necessarily imbibes the element of deriving pleasure with a sense of achievement and accomplishment during the process of learning. MONTESSORI SCHOOL

"By the age of three the child has already laid down the foundation of his personality as a human being and only then does he need the help of special scholastic influences"

Maria Montessori

Montessori philosophy is a child-centred developmental educational method, based on the theories of child development originated by Italian educator Maria Montessori (1870-1952). Maria Montessori believed the early years of a child's life to be the most important for developing the child's intelligence. Entering our classroom, you will immediately notice a calm but busy atmosphere, where the children are involved in small groups or individual activities. The equipment they are using was largely designed by Maria Montessori, to develop the child's concentration, co-ordination and independence. The children are given freedom within a structured environment to choose activities that interest them, and to work with the materials for as long as they need. We support the need for each child to develop their learning and their own individual pace.

Pre Nursery/Montessori- At MPS Pallavpuram Montessori School, we offer a caring and progressive environment for children aged from 2.6 months to 3 years. A child passing through our Montessori programme has the best chance of emerging as a strong young adult. They will be able to make up their own mind, take their place in society as a responsible member and make choices and think independently.





ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The elementary school houses 3 early years of planned education: Balvatika-1, Balvatika-2, Balvatika-3

RAIVATIKA - 1

Nursery program is a four and a half hour program for age group two years ten months to three years. The curriculum for Nursery has been designed to help a child unfold her/his talents, to enable and guide him/her to sharpen his/her mental and physical abilities. Teachers align content, pedagogy, activities, experiences and opportunities for Play, exploration, discovery and problem solving in order to develop life long learning.

BALVATIKA - 2

The L.K.G program is a four and a half hour program, for children from the ages of three years ten months to four years. The foundations of this program are based on the principles of free progressive education that are lead by a curriculum of arts, science, music and movement. This also creates an atmosphere that encourages the child's ability to learn a second language as a language other than the mother tongue. The base of this program is child led, awakening the child's natural instinct for learning.

BALVATIKA - 3

The U.K.G program is a four and a half hour program, for children from the ages of four years ten months to five years. This program is also based on the principles of free progressive education led by a curriculum of arts, science, music and movement. At this stage, emotional independence is encouraged amongst children. Once again, this program encourages bilingualism in languages other than the mother tongue.

MPS INTEGRATES HERB KITCHEN GARDENS, TREE HOUSES, ROPE BRIDGES, SENSORIAL PATHS, WATER, FRUIT GROVES INTO PLAY AND LEARNING SPACES, QUANT STORY AND ART SPACES ARE CREATED TO MAKE THE ELEMENTARY WING A PIVOTAL FOUNDATION OF OUR CURRICULUM OF SUPPORT, LOVE AND UNDERSTANDING AROUND EACH CHILD'S INDIVIDUAL NEEDS.



JUNIOR SCHOOL

The junior school is close to the preschool and has an independent access as well. It houses class one, two, three, four and five.

In the formative years junior school plays an important role in a student's life. MPS Junior School represents a promise to deliver quality education that emphasizes on the inculcation of a deep rooted value system. Our educational process is aimed at empowering the child's intellect and simultaneously supporting their emotional, moral and physical well-being.

UNIQUE LEARNING PROGRAMME @ MPS

Concept-based curriculum connects Pre-primary & Primary learning programme through age appropriate benchmarks that outline the knowledge, skills and understanding required for each subject in each grade. Areas of Academic learning are English, Mathematics, Science, Social Sciences, Visual Art, Music Physical Education and an additional language. We provide Child-centered, nature inspired programme is offered in the school. The Service programme, a part of our curriculum, develops awareness of others, empathy and caring through direct engagement with the community and students in other grades.

Skill-based Learning

Skill-based learning provides classroom environments where independence, thinking skills, collaboration and active learning are developed at the same time as knowledge is acquired. To become skills-based we flip it. Our curricular describe a progression of skills and the knowledge we select, upon which we bring these skills to bear, is secondary. No longer do we think, "Would fractions be a good context for them to develop resilience and perseverance?"

Integrated Science and Social Studies

CREATIVE EXPLORATIONS @ N



As essential soul food, music must be an integral part of every child's life. Here, they will be sensitized and introduced to every school of musical thought, across genres - whether western or eastern, instrumental or vocal, classical or contemporary.



STORY TELLING

Story telling sessions are held regularly, and will not be restricted to just classes, but will also take place in the library. Stories will be absorbed through art and craft, conversation, drama, playacting and songs. Through stories we want to inculcate in children good habits, values, good eating habits, health and hygiene, good conduct and knowledge and of course a vivid imagination. Both classrooms and the library will provide a wide variety of books for children and parents to read and take home. Puppetry and costumes to enact stories, both traditional and from immediate surroundings, will also form a part of our story telling lexicon.



ART AND CRAFT

Children will be encouraged to see art and craft not as 'tasks to be completed', but as activities of creativity and consciousness for the environment. We believe in recycling and reusing all our resources. Art and craft will complement academic schedules and routine.



CLAY & POTTERY

This is a medium, once again used to explore the multifacets of a child creativity. An exercise, not dictated by learning outcomes, but by the experience of creation, and the tactile pleasure of moulding a material that stimultaneously calms and stimulates the child's inspirations.





ORIGAMI

The ancient Japanese art is incorporated along with the children's exposure to other art form. This exercise initiates the child into experimenting with and exploring the dynamics of paper art, from a young age.



KITCHEN BASED **ACTIVITIES**

Through this experiential learning children will learn lessons in independence. With cooking lessons, we aim to wean children off being codependent on the existing systems in place at home. (All safely precautions will be observed to ensure that the child is safe at all times.)



Incorporating both eastern and western sensibilities, emphasis will be on regular dance routines and experimentation, where children will be initiated into classical and contemporary music and rhythm.

HOBBY CLASSES-

Regardless of age, most children have one or the other hobbies. Some take an instant liking to badminton and some love athletics. While some like to play a musical instrument, some go as far as disassembling and assembling products. If you have seen your child pursuing anything very closely other than academics, you have a good idea of where their interests lie. While some children may have one hobby, some may have more hobbies eventually settling down to one or two of their choice. While children's interests may change over time, even the temporary ones may leave a long-lasting impact on their learning and development.

At MPS Pallaypuram, equal importance is given to students' hobbies. Special Hobby classes are run in regular routine to ensure holistic development of students.


YOGA

OUT DOOR LEARNING SPACES - TRACK & FIELD

Outdoor learning spaces are specifically designed to engage children in play that enriches their social, physical and cognitive and creative development. Our outdoor environments provide spaces where children can play, take risks, explore and experiment making decisions at their own level. The children learn to take responsibility for their ides, thoughts and actions to solve problems and engage in their own learning more independently.



LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION

Our focus on life skills begins at early age, initially through the Montessori curriculum of exercises in practical life. However, this soon transcends an early exploration of self in relation to the world around, and progresses to an outdoor engagement with nature.



GYMNASTICS

This exercise helps children gain strength flexibility, balance and control over their body, further enhancing their physical and mental stability.
