

Curriculum



CURRICULUM

The school abides with "core essentials" and thrust on "experiential learning and critical thinking" as the major strike through of NEP 2020

Our curriculum design fosters a dynamic and engaging educational environment that reflects latest pedagogical advancements and the evolving needs of the students. It resonates with the National Curriculum Framework and our commitment to providing a well rounded and comprehensive learning environment.

The "10 + 2" structure will be replaced with "5 + 3 + 3 + 4" model.

Foundational Stage: This is further subdivided into two parts: 3 years of pre-school followed by classes 1 and 2 in primary school. The focus of studies will be on activity-based learning.

Preparatory Stage: Classes 3 to 5, which will cover the ages of 8–11 years. The school has introduced modified learning skills combined with speaking, reading, writing, physical education, languages, art, science and mathematics.

Middle Stage: Classes 6 to 8, covering children between ages 11 and 14. We encourage the middle students to grasp more abstract concepts in subjects of mathematics, sciences, social sciences, arts and humanities. An activity based learning along with virtual interactive session is the core of the crux.

Secondary Stage: Classes 9 to 12, covering the ages of 14–19 years. It is again subdivided into two parts: classes 9 and 10 covering the first phase while classes 11 and 12 covering the second phase. These 4 years of study are intended to inculcate multidisciplinary study, coupled with depth and critical thinking. Multiple options of subjects will be provided.

The school hails the policy that aims at reducing the curriculum load of students and allowing them to be more "inter-disciplinary" and "multi-lingual".

Skill Education

The school aims at incorporating skills and vocational education preparing students to meet the demands of the modern workforce.

SAFAL: SUCCESS BEGINS HERE

MUSIC, DANCE AND DRAMATICS

Facilities

A Home Science Lab is especially maintained for girls opting for Home Science as a subject. The Lab is well equipped with advanced and modern kitchen gadgets-microwave, fridge, mixer etc.

FASHION STUDIES LAB

A very spacious and airy Fashion Studies Lab is well designed for girls opting for Fashion Studies with ample of sewing machines, drafting tables, dress forms etc.

FINE ARTS LAB

A proper ventilated and spacious Fine Arts Lab is with facility of easel board, tables for Fine Arts students.

COMPUTER LABS

Computer literacy is promoted through the well equipped Computer Lab from class I onwards. There are three Computer Labs for Primary, Middle and Senior students separately. COUNSELLING CELL

Facilities for aptitude tests and career counselling are also available. The school takes a special care for making its students mentally and physically healthy by conducting online and offline counselling sessions on wellbeing issues.

STAFF AND FACULTY

The staff is well qualified, trained, experienced & Competent. Apart from imparting content of knowledge of various disciplines, they act as mentors and guides providing them with counselling and direction. School Rules

- Students must attend the school in proper school uniform.
 Uniform is compulsory for all school functions and on Parent Teacher Meetings.
- Students are expected to be punctual. Reporting time on all days will be five minutes before the first bell. Entry will not be permitted subsequently.
- During the school hours students will not be permitted to leave the premises without prior sanction of the Principal and that too only in case of an emergency.
- Students are not allowed to receive visitors during school hours. Lunch/Tiffin boxes will not be delivered to the child under any circumstances.
- Students are expected to abstain from bringing any printed material not related to syllabus.
- · Cell phones and cameras are not allowed in the school campus
- Children cannot use any forms of ornamentation which includes jewellery or expensive watches. Mehendi to be applied only if there is a wedding in the family (card to be submitted with a written application)
- School property must be taken care of by the students. Writing
 or scribbling on the walls or causing damage to school
 property will be treated as a breach of discipline and the
 student will be expected to pay for the damage incurred.
- Overall 90% attendance is compulsory. No student will be absent from school without obtaining prior sanction from the Principal. A leave application duly signed by the parent must be submitted to class teacher in advance.
- Absence in case of emergency/sudden illness or unforeseen circumstances must be intimated to the school the next day.
- In case of illness of more than 3 days, Medical Certificate by a registered Medical Practitioner should be enclosed along with the leave application.
- Students suffering from infectious/contagious disease shall, under no circumstances, be permitted to attend school until fully recovered.

- If a student is absent for more than 10 days without prior sanction, the name is liable to be struck off the school rolls. Readmission, if granted, shall be done after payment of readmission fee.
- Disobedience and disrespect towards teachers or bad moral influence will justify dismissal of the student.
- The school shall not be held responsible for any unforeseen accident, illness or mishap which may occur during school hours or school trips.
- Parents' attendance is mandatory at all Parents Teacher Meetings.
- Fee is to be paid by the 10th of every month, failing which a late fee fine will be charged.
- Parents are requested to cooperate in the working of the school.
- As regards Promotion/Detention the decision of the Principal is final.
- It is mandatory to maintain a minimum 60% marks throughout the session to avail the benefit of any kind of fee concession provided to the students, failing which all concession will be withdrawn with immediate effect.
- Decision regarding allotment and interchange of section while a new session is being made is the prerogative of only school authorities and is always taken in the best interest of the student.
- It is mandatory for all new admissions to submit three passport and one stamp sized photograph, original transfer certificate, photocopy of birth certificate by Municipal Corporation and report card of the school last attended by 30th of April, failing which the admission would stand cancelled without the refund of admission charges.
- Student's Identity Card should be worn at all times.
- Parents will be granted entry into the school only if they carry the parents Identity Card with them.

- * Attested copy of Caste certificate for SC/SC/OBC of Father/Student. (if applicable)
- * Last date of submitting TC is 30 April, 2025, otherwise admission will automatically be considered as cancelled.
