TO GREATER HEIGHTS

National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 & NCFSE

Our curriculum aligns with the NEP 2020 and the National Curriculum Framework for School Education (NCFSE), ensuring students receive a balanced and inclusive education. We emphasize Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) in the early years, focusing on play-based and activity-based learning. We also implement skill-based learning, integrating core competencies from Bloom's Taxonomy to develop higher-order thinking skills.

Stages of Learning:

- Foundational Stage (5 Years):
- Grades: Pre-Primary and Grades 1 & 2
- Focus: Developing linguistic, motor, and socio-emotional skills through play-based and interactive learning methods. We prioritize creating a joyful and safe learning environment where children can explore and grow at their own pace.

- Preparatory Stage (3 Years):
- Grades: 3, 4, and 5
- Focus: Building on foundational knowledge by introducing language, numeracy, and scientific concepts. This stage emphasizes hands-on learning and the development of core skills with exposure to multiple languages, particularly the mother tongue.
- Middle Stage (3 Years):
- Grades: 6 and 7
- Focus: Transitioning from concrete to abstract learning through experiential and inquiry-based methods. This stage enhances students' understanding of subjects like Mathematics, Science, and Social Science, while also fostering critical thinking, problem-solving, and communication skills.

Quaint Story and Art Spaces

Specially designed spaces, such as art and storytelling areas, form the cornerstone of our foundational stage, supporting the holistic development of each child. These spaces are crucial for fostering creativity, love, and understanding, while catering to each student's unique needs.

FOUNDATIONAL STAGE

The Foundational Stage is very important as it sets the groundwork for a child's educational journey. This stage includes children aged 3 to 8 years, covering Nursery, Lower KG, Upper KG, and Classes 1 and 2.

In this nurturing environment, children begin to learn about their surroundings, making the school feel like a second home. The classrooms are bright and cheerful, featuring a 'Fun Room' and special activity spaces that make learning enjoyable.

An ideal student-teacher ratio is maintained to ensure that each child receives personal care from qualified and experienced staff. PREPARATORY STAGE

MIDDLE STAGE

Facilities

STAFF AND FACULTY

Our staff comprises well-qualified, trained, experienced, and competent professionals. Beyond imparting subject knowledge, they act as mentors and guides, providing students with essential counselling and direction to help them grow holistically.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

Our school boasts a well-stocked library and reading room, open to students during school hours. This inviting space is filled with a diverse collection of books, magazines, and other learning resources that cater to all age groups and interests.

FUN ROOM

Children become self-regulated through concentration on stimulating self-chosen tasks that they can pursue individually or in groups. The Fun Room encourages self-discipline, self-knowledge, academic skills, problem-solving ability, and an enthusiasm for learning through engaging activities.

COMPOSITE LAB

The practical aspects of teaching are suitably catered to through spacious, well-equipped laboratories for physics, chemistry, biology, computer, and bio-technology. The labs are well-provided with sufficient equipment, enabling hands-on learning and experimentation.

COMPUTER SCIENCE LAB

Computer literacy is a key focus at our school, with state-of-theart computer labs accessible from Kindergarten to Class VII. Students are encouraged to utilize online resources to enhance their learning, helping them become proficient and confident in the digital world.

TEACHING AIDS

Our teaching methods are enhanced through a variety of aids, including charts, flash cards, models, specimens, maps, and audio-visual tools. Smart panels and Real-Life Learning (RLL) experiences are integrated into the teaching process to make lessons more engaging and effective.

PROJECT WORK

Classroom learning is supplemented with project work. Students create working models, file projects, and PowerPoint presentations using reference material from the library and the Internet, encouraging creativity and practical understanding.

BUS SERVICE

Our school buses cover all routes within Meerut and its suburbs, providing an easy and reliable transport facility. All buses are equipped with GPS tracking, ensuring safety and peace of mind for parents and guardians.

CCTV SURVEILLANCE

The entire school campus is under 24-hour CCTV surveillance, ensuring the security of students and staff at all times.

AC CAMPUS

Our school features a fully air-conditioned campus, providing a comfortable and conducive learning environment for students across all age groups.













School Rules

- Students must come to school in proper School Uniform.
 Uniform is compulsory at all school functions, Parent
 Teacher Meetings and on any visit the child may make to the school during working hours.
- Students must be punctual. Reporting time on all days will be five minutes before the first bell. Entry will not be permitted subsequently.
- During school hours students will not be permitted to leave the premises without prior sanction of the Principal and that too only in any emergency.
- Students are not allowed to receive visitors during school hours. Lunch/Tiffin boxes will NOT be delivered to the child under any circumstances.
- Students are prohibited from carrying objectionable literature/material to school.
- The use of cell phones is strictly prohibited within the school premises. Confiscation will lead to the imposition of a Rs. 500 fine.
- The use of mehndi / other forms of ornamentation which include jewellery or expensive watches is not permitted.
- School property must be taken care of by the students.
 Writing of scribbling on the walls or causing damage to school property will be treated as a breach of discipline and the student will be expected to pay for the damage incurred.
- Overall 85% attendance is compulsory. No student will be absent from school without obtaining prior sanction from

- the Principal. A leave application duly signed by the parent must be submitted to the Class Teacher in advance.
- Absence in case of emergency / sudden illness or unforeseen circumstances must be intimated to the school the next day.
- The students' absence from the school in the beginning of the session for 14 consecutive days would be considered as NSO (Name Struck Off) with no update of status from the Parents' or Guardians' side.
- Absence of student for seven days continuously/collectively anytime during the session without any intimation shall again be considered as NSO.
- Parents need to clear outstanding dues, by the 10th of every month, if the amount stated is pending for more than 2 months it shall be considered as NSO.
- Disobedience and disrespect towards teachers or bad moral influence will justify dismissal of the student.
- The school shall not be held responsible for any unforeseen accident or illness of mishap which may occur during school hours or school trips.
- Parents' attendance is mandatory at all Parent Teacher Meetings.
- As regards Promotion / Detention the decision of the Principal is final.


