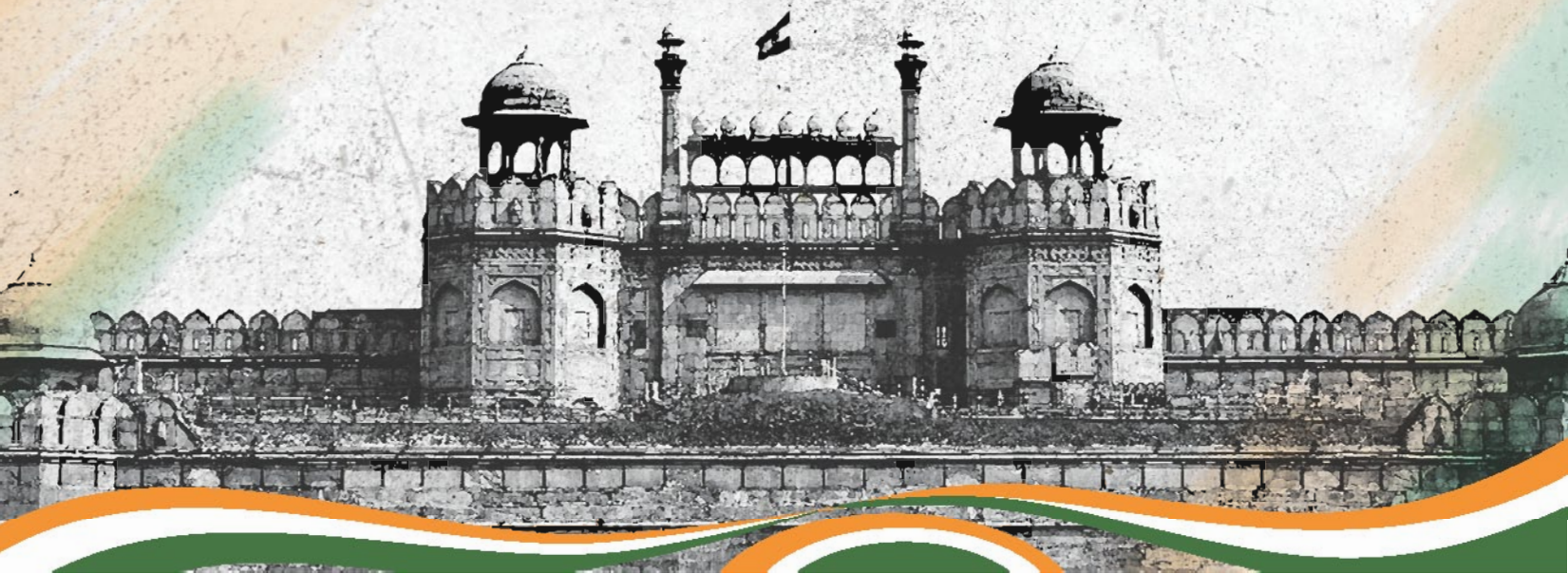

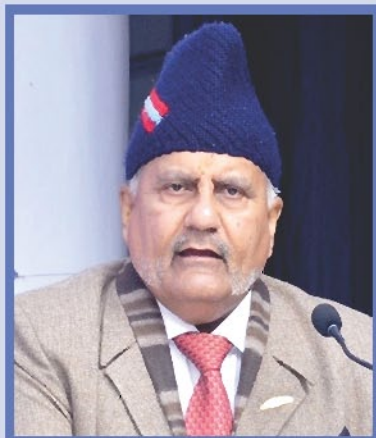
Thank you so much for the invitation. I am glad and privileged that I was a part of Travel Logs competition.

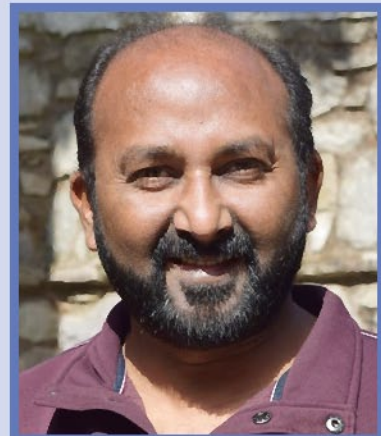

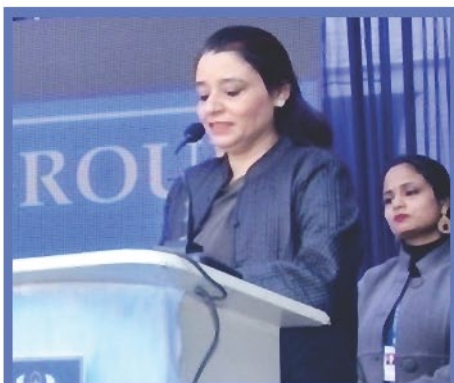

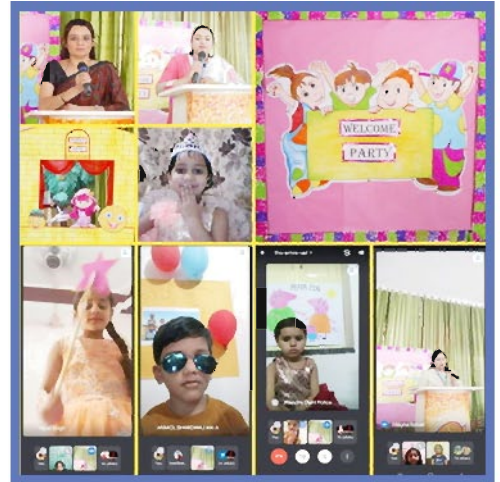
WELCOME PARTY

JANMASHTAMI CELEBRATION

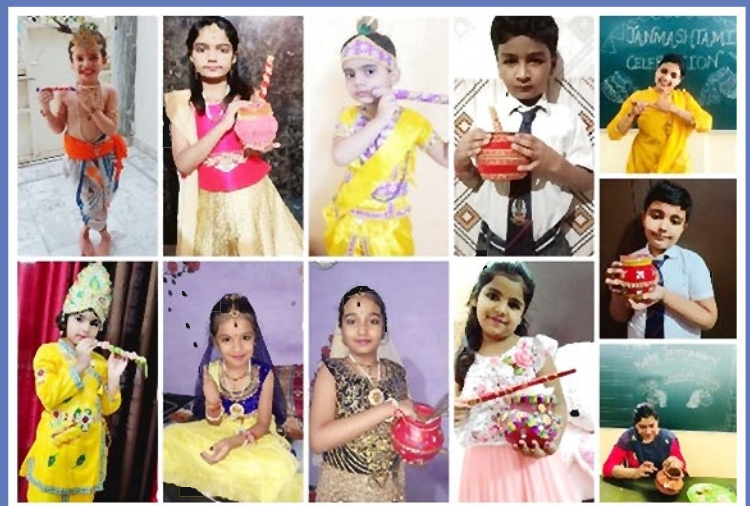

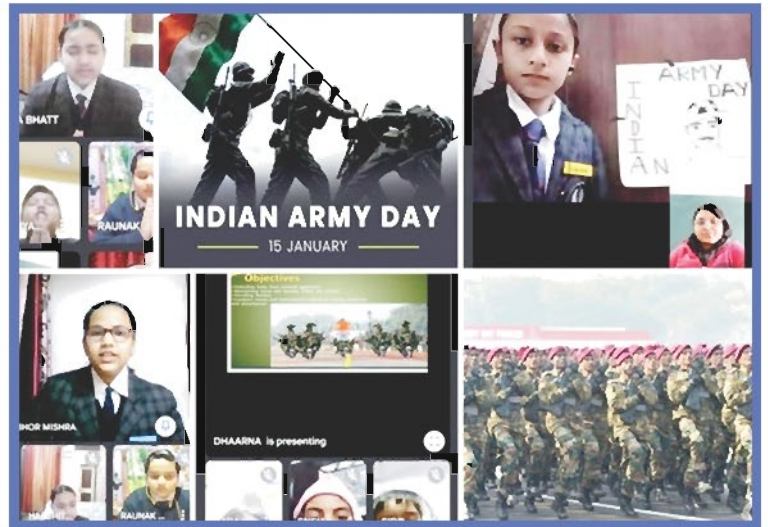

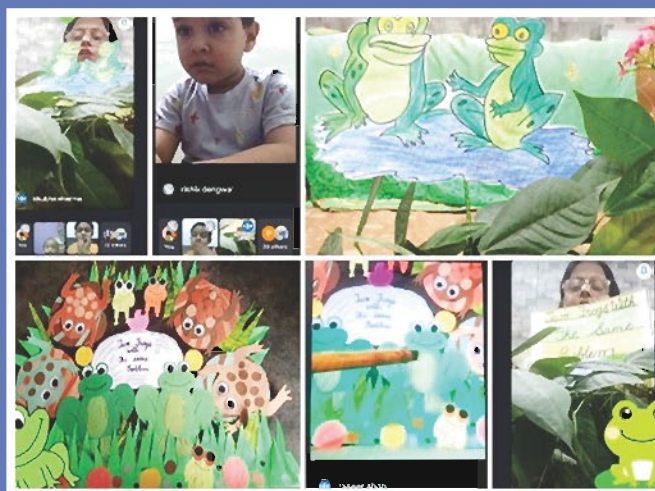

YOGA MAHOTSAV - DAY 1

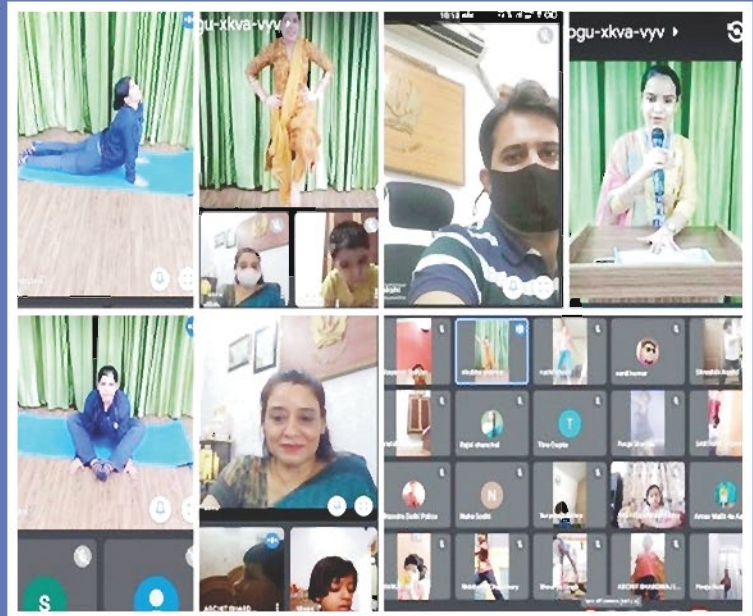
'Physical Fitness Is not only one of the most important keys to a healthy body, it is the basis of dynamic and creative Intellectual activity.'

Yoga Mahotsav - Day 2 : Session On Emotional Wellbeing

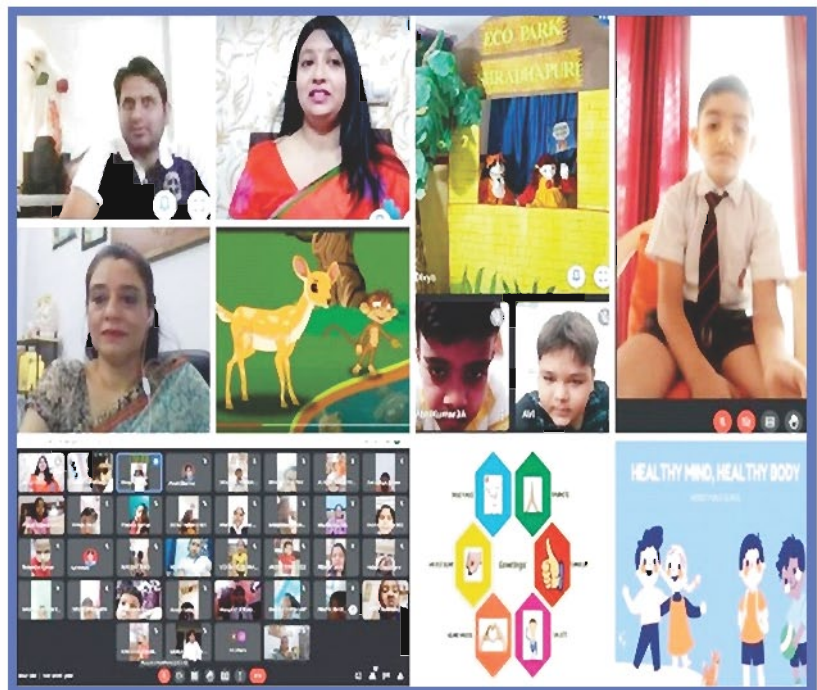

READING MAHOTSAVA : DAY 1

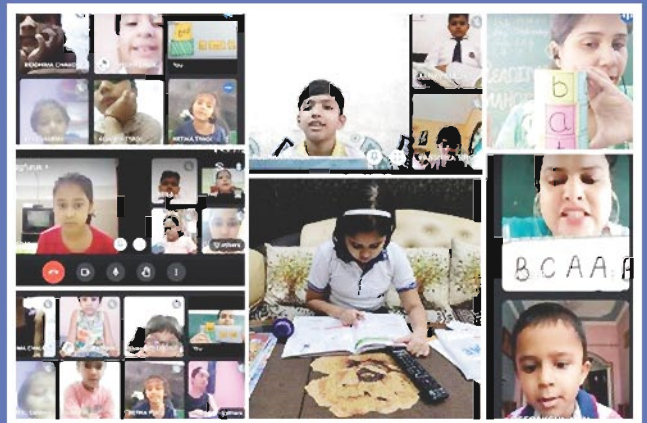
