### Assessments aligned with NCFSE

At Meerut Public School, The First Step, we follow a structured and developmentally appropriate assessment pattern across all stages:

- Foundational Stage (Balvatika 1 to Grade 2): Continuous formative assessments are conducted and carefully documented through the Holistic Progress Card (HPC), focusing on the overall development of each child.
- Preparatory Stage (Grades 3 to 5): Students are assessed through a combination of Formative Assessments (FAs) and Summative Assessments (SAs), along with Open Door Assessments, which encourage critical thinking and conceptual understanding.
- Middle Stage (Grades 6-7): The academic year includes two Summative Assessments, which promote deeper learning aligned with NCFSE goals.

#### **Enhancing Academic Excellence**

We promote high academic standards through consistent, quality instructions, experiential learning methods and Open Door Assessment. Remedial and enrichment classes help bridge learning gaps and extend high-achievers through enriched learning opportunities.

#### Open Door Assessment

Open Door (Preparatory Stage) enriches classroom learning by offering real-time feedback and identifying areas needing reinforcement for the subjects Science and Mathematics. It supports concept mastery and problem-solving skills.

#### Capacity Building Workshops

Regular internal and external workshops equip teachers with NCFSE aligned methods, technology integration and assessment tools. Ongoing training fosters creative teaching methods that inspire deeper understanding.

#### **Parent Teacher Meeting**

To foster effective communication between Parents and Teachers, regular PTMs are conducted. Help desks are also set up during PTMs to assist parents with Google Classroom and Entab-related queries.

## REAL-LIFE INTEGRATED PEDAGOGY-LEARNING BY DOING

We believe in learning by doing. Our classrooms are interactive and imaginative learning spaces where students explore concepts through hands-on activities that connect theory with real-life situations. Here are some examples of experiential learning across subjects:

### Show and Sell-Money

To understand the concept of money, students set up small stalls using fake currency. Through role-play, they engaged in buying and selling items, gaining experience of value, exchange, and simple transactions.







### Air Occupies Space -Using a Balloon

By blowing balloons and observing them expand, students discovered how air occupies space. This joyful and engaging learning experience transformed a science topic into an exciting, real-world discovery.

### Observe the Hands and Tell the Time

Using model clocks, children practiced reading the hour and minute hands. This method helped them understand how to tell time with ease and accuracy.



# **Identify Vowel Sound Using Letters on Stick** Students used letter sticks to identify

vowel sounds in words. This playful activity supported phonics learning and sharpened their sound recognition skills.
