Curriculum:

At Meerut Public School, The First Step curriculum aligns with the National Curriculum Framework for School Education (NCFSE), ensuring holistic and well-rounded education.

Assessment Pattern:

Our school follows a structured assessment pattern across all stages.

Foundational Stage (Balvatika 1 to Grade 2): Continuous formative assessments are conducted and carefully documented through the Holistic Progress Card (HPC), focusing on the overall development of each child.

Preparatory Stage (Grades 3 to 5): Students are assessed through a combination of Formative Assessments (FAs) and Summative Assessments (SAs), along with Open Door Assessments, which encourage critical thinking and conceptual understanding.

Middle Stage (Grades 6-7): Students are assessed through a combination of Formative Assessments (FAs) and two Summative Assessments, which promote deeper learning aligned with NCFSE goals.

Enhancing Academic Excellence:

We promote high academic standards through consistent, quality instructions, experiential learning methods and Open Door Assessment. Remedial and enrichment classes help bridge learning gaps and extend high-achievers through enriched learning opportunities.

Open Door Assessment:

Open Door (Preparatory Stage) enriches classroom learning by offering real-time feedback and identifying areas needing reinforcement for the subjects Science and Mathematics. It supports concept mastery and problem-solving skills.

Modern Classrooms for Enhanced Learning:

We offer modern, air-conditioned classrooms equipped with smart panels, providing an interactive and comfortable learning environment for students.

Science & Technology Labs:

Composite Science Lab: Fully equipped for practical experiments, fostering curiosity and scientific exploration.

Computer Science Lab: State-of-the-art lab with Chromebooks, enhancing students' digital learning and technological skills.

Creative & Recreational Spaces:

Dance Room: Encourages rhythm, movement and self-expression.

Music Room: Nurtures musical talent and appreciation.

Fun Room: A space for creative play, social interaction, and experiential learning.

Library:

Our well-stocked library inspires a love for reading, research, and independent learning among students.

Capacity Building Workshops:
